Premier Premiership – Fling (5 steps), Lilt (4 steps) REST PREMIERSHIP SAME

STEPS REQUIRED FOR SECTIONS:- Unless mentioned previously number of steps for dance sections will be as follows:- Fling (4), Swords (2 x 1), Seann Triubhas (3 x 1), Reel (2 x 2), Jig (4), Hornpipe (4), Blue Bonnets (4) Laddie (4), Barracks Johnnie (4), Lilt (4), Flora (4).

PLEASE NOTE:-

- Age to be taken at day of competition.
- Age groups re section dances to be determined by the entries received.
- Judges decision to be final.
- Committee deserves the right to make alterations and additions.
- Competitors dance at their own risk.
- Registration cards must be presented to received numbers.
- Any complaint made by an individual against the organisation or adjudication of an event must be made in writing giving the complainant's full name and address, and shall be lodged with the organiser if possible on the day of the event and certainly not later than 48 hours after the event. Such a complaint to be accompanied by \$5.00 fee (as determined by the ABHDI) which is refundable if protest is upheld.
- Dancers must "fill in" if requested by the organiser. If an competitor fails to fill in unless for a medical reason the organiser has the right to enforce Rule 11), page 28 D Judges, SOBHD rules and Regulations, which reads – "Provided due prominence is given to the fact in the programme or in a brochure by the organiser, then during the course of a competition the comportment of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behavior on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanor likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification, but a full report of any misconduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the judges to the organiser".
